Rules

- 1. Phones, calculators and smartwatches are not allowed during the test.
- 2. Participants must adhere to a time limit of 12-15 minutes maximum. A warning may be given when the time limit is approaching. Any misbehavior will lead to disqualification from the competition.
- 3. Students must carry a copy of their resume for the interview round.
- 4. The decision of the judging panel is final and binding. Any disputes or appeals will not be entertained.
- 5. Participants must arrive at the competition venue at least 15 minutes before their scheduled time to set up.
- 6. Participants are advised to wear college uniforms only during the Technical and HR interview rounds.
- 7. Participants are encouraged to engage with the audience and respond to questions during the GD and interview round.







- 8. Participants should maintain professional conduct and respect towards fellow participants, judges, and event coordinators throughout the event.
- 9. Note: The mock placement competition is mandatory for all second year and third year Chemical Engineering and Bioengineering students.

Judging Criteria

1. Aptitude test

- Question paper will be of 60 marks containing 40 questions.
- Time limit 60 mins.
- Further shortlisting will be done based on the current test scores.

2. Group Discussion

- For the second round there will be a group of around 12 people for group discussion
- Random topics will be given by the coordinators.
- Participants will be judged by their skills and their presenting skills on the relevant topic.
- The shortlisting will be done based on the performance.

3. Personal Interview

- The interview will be taken by the Industrial professionals.
- Interview will be one-on-one.
- Judge based on skill, communication and knowledge in the industry.
