Judging Criteria

- 1. **Clarity of Problem Statement:** Evaluate how clearly the team defines the problem they are addressing and its significance.
- 2. **Research on Existing Solutions:** Assess the depth and quality of the team's research on existing solutions or approaches related to the problem.
- 3. **Novelty of Approach:** Determine the originality and creativity of the team's approach to solving the problem.
- 4. **Clarity of Idea:** Evaluate how well the team communicates their idea and its components clearly and understandably.
- 5. **Unique Selling Point:** Identify the unique features or advantages that make the team's idea stand out from others.
- 6. **Economic Feasibility:** Assess the practicality and financial viability of implementing the team's idea within real-world economic constraints.
- 7. **Scale of Impact:** Evaluate the potential impact and reach of the team's solution on addressing the problem at a significant scale.
- 8. **Potential for Future Work:** Consider the potential for further development, refinement, and expansion of the team's idea in the future.
- 9. **Commercialization Plan:** Assess the team's strategy and plan for commercializing their idea, if applicable.
- 10. **Scalability:** Evaluate the scalability of the team's solution, i.e., its ability to adapt and grow to meet increasing demands or challenges.
- 11. Adherence to the Template: Check if the team follows the prescribed format or template for their presentation and documentation.

Dos and Don'ts

Dos

- Follow the specified team size
- Stick to the presentation slide limit and the template
- Present within the allocated time and participate in the Q&A session
- Ensure your idea is original and creative

Don'ts

- Exceed the team size limit
- Go over the presentation slide limit
- Exceed the presentation time limit
- Plagiarize or present an unoriginal idea
